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Organization Defined Parameters (ODP)

ODPs are embedded in certain security requirements, giving organizations the flexibility to tailor controls to their specific environments through **assignment** and **selection** operations.

Customize Requirements

Tailor security requirements to specific protection needs using assignment and selection operations.

Guided by Policy

ODP values are informed by laws, Executive Orders, directives, regulations, standards, and mission or business needs.

Support Assessments

Enable consistent security assessments to determine whether specified requirements are satisfied.

Organization Assignment

If a federal agency does not specify values, nonfederal organizations must assign them to complete the requirement.
